CARE & MAINTENANCE

- To protect the surface more efficiently and keep your floor looking like new, clean your floor by using a neutral PH vinyl floor cleaner such as LONG LIFE.* This product requires no rinsing after application.
- Do not use wax.
- Scuff marks, various types of shoe soles may cause scuff marks. If scuff marks appear, we recommend you identify the cause eg. joggers/runners and remove. No claims will be accepted for scuff marks.
- Avoid surface scratches by sweeping or vacuuming your floor as often as necessary to remove loose dirt. Weekly maintenance should be carried out by washing the floor with a neutral PH vinyl floor cleaner such as LONG LIFE.*
- Furniture pads should be used underneath all items of furniture to protect your new floor!
- DO NOT place any rubber backed items, including rubber mats on your floor to avoid permanent staining.
- Never use steam mops on your floor. Use a damp mop only. Avoid excessive amounts of water.
- Avoid direct sunlight on your floor for prolonged periods of time by using appropriate window treatments or a UV resistant film on the windows. Windows, glass doors and skylights which are exposed to sun or heat can create high floor surface temperatures, while our products are manufactured to be stable all flooring should be protected from high temperatures and sunlight. The use of temperature and humidity controllers, along with window treatments, blinds and window tinting is recommended in these situations. Dramatic temperature changes or extreme humidity can cause joins to lip/peak or gapping. Prolonged exposure to sunlight (UV) can cause fading. These items are not covered by manufacturers warranty.
